## Parental Statement of Cooperation

**As a parent I understand:** That **Town East Christian School** is an integral, inseparable ministry of **Town East Baptist Church**. **Town East Baptist Church and School** have the absolute right of self-government, free from the interference of any hierarchy of individuals, organizations or civil government that opposes clear scriptural commands or principles. The will of this local assembly, under the leadership of the Pastor, is final. Attendance at **Town East Christian School** is a privilege and not a right. Students forfeit this privilege if they do not conform to the standards, principles, procedures and philosophy of education of **Town East Christian School**. The Administration may insist on the withdrawal of a student at any time the student or parents, in the opinion of the School, does not conform to the spirit of this ministry of **Town East Baptist Church**.

**I understand:** The policy of Town East Christian School is to give advance notice of change whenever possible, to permit adjustment, however, Town East Christian School reserves the right to make changes at any time it is deemed necessary. Town East Christian School admits students of any race, color, nationality or ethnic origins to all rights and privileges, programs and activities available to students. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, nationality or ethnic origin in the administration of its educational policies, admissions policies, athletics or other school administered programs.

**I agree:** To hold the School and its agents harmless for any liability to my child or any guardian or parent thereof because of any claims on behalf of my child against the School or any agent thereof because of any injury or alleged injury to my child. Should legal action, for any reason, be taken against Town East Baptist Church and School, or any employee or agent thereof, on my child's behalf and the School or its agents not be found at fault, I agree to pay all attorney fees, court costs, damages, or any other costs that Town East Christian School or its agent should incur to defend itself against such action.

**I further understand:** To support and fully cooperate with the School in any matter that might arise as long as my child is in attendance at Town East Christian School. I understand that parental cooperation and support are expected or my child/children may be asked to withdraw, at the discretion of the School Administration. Also, at any time I feel that I cannot support the doctrine, leadership, and/or policies of the School, I will withdraw my child or children.

## Corporal Correction Form

Town East Christian School is honored that you have entrusted our administration to assist you in training your child. Our total school program is designed to develop the spiritual, social and academic qualities that your child possesses. We appreciate your confidence in our program.

In order to carry out your wishes for effective character development, we believe it is necessary to follow scriptural admonition in correcting a child when his behavior or attitude is in violation of proper and reasonable rules and procedures. One facet of discipline is paddling. Should this type of correction ever become necessary, the following guidelines are our usual approach.

- The offense will be clearly discussed with the child.
- A staff member will discuss the scriptural principles and will pray with the student.
- A reasonable number of firm swats will be given to the child by a staff member of the same sex as the child. A simple, flat wooden paddle will be used for swatting.
- A staff member will be present as a witness.
- The child will not be physically restrained. If he refuses to submit to the paddling, the parents will be contacted as soon as possible to come in for a conference. If it is felt to be in the best interest of the School, the child may be suspended or expelled.
- After administering the swats, the staff member will reassure the child of their love and acceptance of them. If no repentance is evidenced on the child's part, further counseling, discipline, and/or a parental conference may be needed.
- The parents will be notified in writing of the corporal correction. This notification must be signed and returned the following day. If the student returns without the slip, he/she is temporarily suspended from class until a parent comes to the school office and signs his child back into class.

Generally speaking, students are given lines for procedure violations and swats for moral violations. Examples of moral violations are: lying, cussing, stealing, cheating, disrespect for authority, etc. It is possible in the judgment of this administration for a procedure violation to turn into a moral violation. An example of this would be a student who is continually getting into trouble for not doing homework. If lines are not developing the desired effect, the only alternative would be swats.

I have read the above and agree to support the Town East Christian School and its administration concerning this policy. I personally pledge my support to this scriptural approach to discipline as long as my child is attending Town East Christian School.

## Standards of Conduct

Town East Christian School holds that the Bible is the infallible, divine Word of God and that salvation by faith in Christ is the initial step in the Christian life. Spiritual growth is an essential process and is carried on throughout the believer's life by the Holy Spirit. Our desire and goal is that students be conformed into the image of Christ. The Holy Spirit makes the true believer conscious of the biblical demands for a holy life which fulfills God's moral law and His higher law of love. The result is a life consecrated unto God and separated from the World.....*Romans 8:29; Romans 12:2; Matthew 22:37; Romans 13:8-10; Galatians 5:14.*

Therefore, Town East Christian School must provide an environment conducive to the spiritual growth and development of our students. In order to provide such an environment, our standard of conduct is based on the following biblical imperatives. The believer should endeavor to avoid practices which cause the loss of sensitivity to the spiritual needs of the world and those which are detrimental to his own physical, mental, or spiritual well-being.....*I Corinthians 8:9; 9:27; 10:13; 10:29-32.*

A sense of the need for spiritual growth in the light of these principles has led Town East Christian School to adopt the following standards which it is believed are conducive to the environment that will best promote the spiritual welfare of the student. The School, therefore, expects each student, whether at home or school:

1. To refrain from swearing, using indecent language, using tobacco in any form, drinking of any kind of alcoholic beverages, the use of non-prescribed drugs, gambling, involvement in certain concerts (those that dishonor our Lord Jesus Christ or disrespect God-ordained authority).
2. To maintain biblical standards (suitable to a believer) in courtesy, kindness, and morality. Such morality would include - though not limited to - abstaining from involvement in any deviation from biblical morality, such as: fornication, homosexuality, pornography, etc.
3. To use the Internet in a manner consistent with standards set forth by Town East Christian School. Students who in the opinion of the administration post inappropriate material online will be expelled immediately.
4. To appreciate the standards of the school and not tolerate profanity, obscenity in word or action, dishonor to our Lord Jesus Christ or to the Word of God, or disrespect to the school staff. To agree to support regulations published in the Student Handbook

The selection of the principles mentioned in this pledge may appear arbitrary to some; but while not condemning others who see differently, Town East Christian School believes that the principles named are outstanding types of conduct which are essential to the standards established as its objective. Students are expected to abide by these standards throughout their enrollment whether at home, school or elsewhere. Students found to be out of harmony with these principles and ideals may be invited to withdraw.
